PACKING LIST - Ohio 2018

** It is expected that all clothing worn by cadets on this weekend will be **modest** in nature and will not be offensive in any way.

No alcohol advertising or vulgar phrases will be tolerated. Parents please double check the clothing your cadet is bringing on the trip. We are ambassadors of Canada and the Air Cadet program.

The following items **MUST** be brought:

- Birth certificate (original) if born in Canada, valid passport or citizenship card for those not born in Canada
- Health card (original)
- Squadron Cadet ID card please let Lt Di Loreto know if you need a card (initial card is free, replacement is \$2)
- 2 navy blue Squadron t-shirts (one each of the bird and the roundel can be purchased at the hall on sign up nights for \$15 each)
- Sunscreen
- Water bottle bring this full of water and with your name marked on it
- Prescription medication in original containers (only enough for duration of the trip)
- Personal toiletries soap, deodorant, toothbrush and toothpaste etc. Shower shoes are recommended, male cadets are required to be clean shaven daily
- Towel
- Combination lock
- Spending money in USD please note, meals are provided, spending money is only for extras
- 4 pairs of underwear
- 4 pairs socks
- Pants x2
- Shorts (conservative)
- Shirts, long and short sleeved (Squadron t-shirts are required for Saturday and Sunday, no objectionable slogans on other Shirts)
- PT gear t-shirt, shorts or athletic pants and running shoes and a baseball glove if you have one
- Jacket
- Rain gear outside events will happen rain or shine
- Shoes
- Sleeping bag & pillow

- ** NOTE Camp Campbell Gard recommends packing in soft duffle bags (no hard luggage or luggage with wheels). All bedding and clothing goes through a heat treatment process in order to keep the camp a bed bug free facility. Space will be at a premium, please pack minimally in one bag that will get put under the bus. Your small backpack that is taken on the bus for snacks and personal entertainment does not need to be heat treated.
